


The most audacious cities have understood that energy constraint could be a great opportunity to reinvent themselves by relying on another vision of the city of tomorrow: a frugal city, reconciling the satisfaction of needs with an economy of means and resources. Illustrating his point with examples from France and Europe, Jean Haëntjens explains the principles of this model by applying it to the various components of our urban system: mobility, spatial planning, utilities accessibility, etc.

This "invitation to philosophize" is for those who have seen the regions of philosophy without ever landing on it, and who may experience this "nostalgia of the land unknown", as Baudelaire wrote.

In ten chapters as many possible destinations, this book explores the multiple facets of lie and truth, those of fear and courage, jealousy and trust, the desire for revenge and forgiveness, love and indifference; then the various forms of the relationship to time, of dream and reality, of theft and possession, disobedience and obedience, perception of life and death.

Each theme is gradually deepened from ordinary situations and feelings, but also stories borrowed from cinema or literature. At the same time, the use of definitions, concepts, discussions or philosophical texts allows for a better understanding and resolution of the issues raised.
