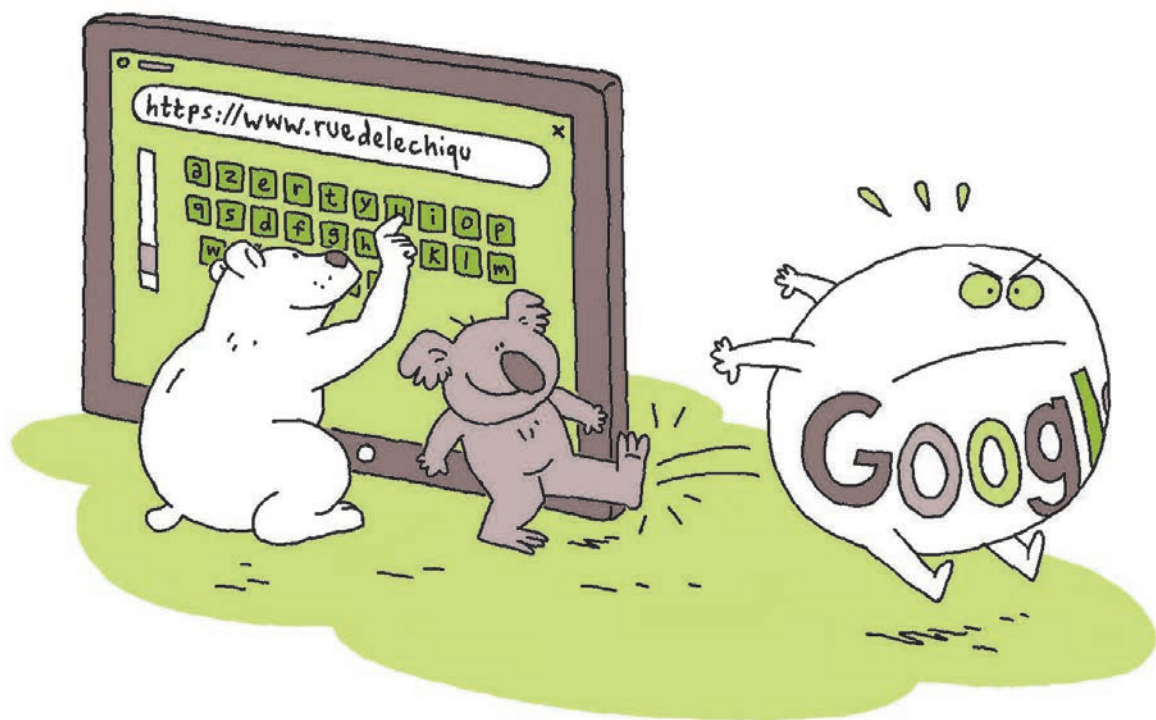

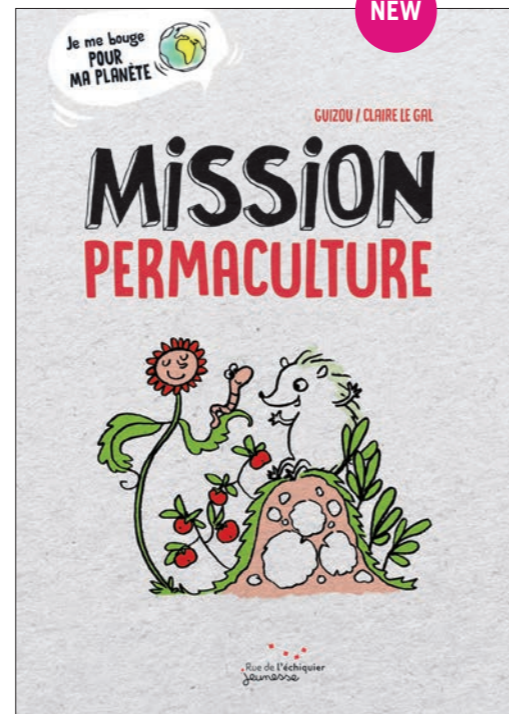

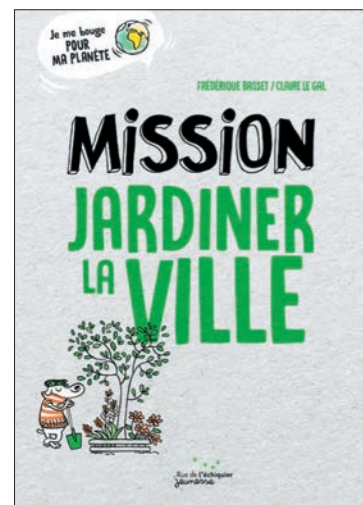
MISSION PERMACULTURE

ZARBI, GIFTED CHILD

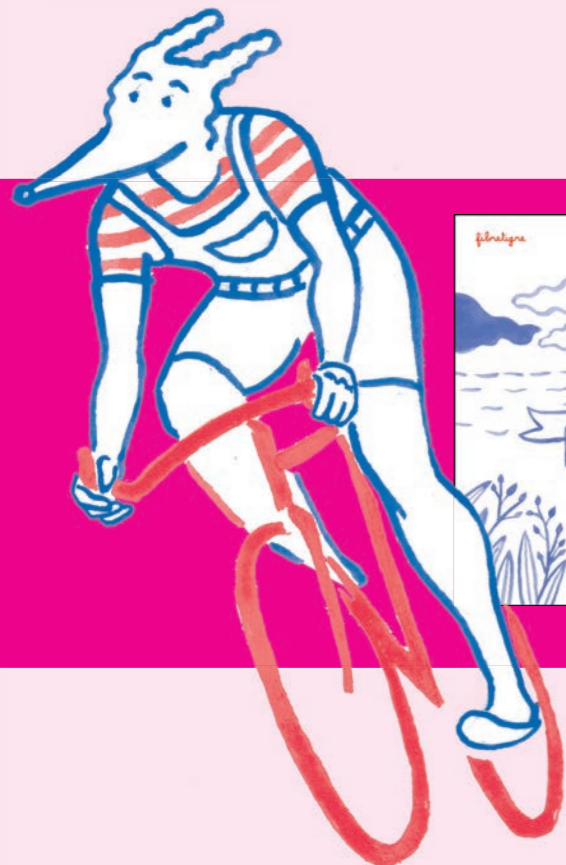
SUZANNE GALÉA AND FLORIANE RICARD
